
SOUTH AFRICAN POLICE SERVICE REGULATIONS FOR THE DIRECTORATE FOR PRIORITY CRIME INVESTIGATION

1. The Minister of Police made Regulations for the Directorate for Priority Crime Investigation (DPCI) which were published in Government Gazette No. 33524 (Government Notice No. R783) on 7 September 2010. (Attached).
2. Regulation 5 of the Regulations contains important information in respect of the retired judge who has been appointed as a complaints mechanism to investigate complaints by the **public** who can provide evidence of a serious and unlawful infringement of his / her rights caused by an investigation by the DPCI or a **member of the DPCI** who can provide evidence of improper influence or interference regarding the conducting of an investigation.
3. Complaints referred to in paragraph 2 *supra* must be made **in writing** on the Complaint Reporting Form (Annexure 1 of the attached Regulations) and may be lodged by e-mail, fax, post or delivery to:
