

## **CURRICULUM VITAE OF GENERAL KJ SITOLE**

General Khehla John Sitole was born in Standerton, Mpumalanga and matriculated in 1984 from the Makhosana High School in Kwandebele.

He joined the South African Police Service on 9 April 1986 as a student constable and became a commissioned officer in 1988.

In 1996, General Sitole was appointed as a senior manager with the rank of Director and in 2000 was appointed as an Assistant Commissioner in Mpumalanga.

In 2006, he was appointed as the Deputy Provincial Commissioner for Human Resource Management in the Northern Cape and in 2010 General Sitole was appointed as the Deputy Provincial Commissioner for Human Resource Management in the Free State.

From 2011 to 2013, General Sitole served as the Provincial Commissioner of the Free State with the rank of Lieutenant General and on the 1<sup>st</sup> October 2013 he was appointed as the Deputy National Commissioner, Policing.

On 1 March 2016, he was appointed as the Divisional Commissioner of Protection and Security Services, a post he held until 22 November 2017 when he was appointed by His Excellency, the President of the Republic of South Africa, Mr JG Zuma, as the National Commissioner of the South African Police Service.
