ENFORCEMENT NOTICE IN TERMS OF SECTION 95 OF THE PROTECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION ACT, 2013 (ACT NO. 4 OF 2013) AND REGULATION 12(2)(C) OF THE REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE PROTECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION, 2018, IN THE MATTER PERTAINING TO THE RELEASE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION OF THE KRUGERSDORP RAPE VICTIMS

The above-mentioned Notice, received by the South African Police Service ('SAPS') on 2023-04-04, has bearing on the matter.

Hereby notice in terms of section 22 of the POPIA of the possible security compromise of your personal information as required in the above-mentioned Notice.

During the process of tracing the suspects in the above-mentioned incident, the SAPS Management of Gauteng, the relevant district, stations and units were alerted of the crime and requested to mobilize resources to trace the suspects. WhatsApp messages were used to communicate due to the urgency of tracing the suspects.

Unfortunately, personal information of the victims were unintentionally disclosed in the WhatsApp messages on SAPS WhatsApp groups, which found its way to social media which may adversely affect you.

The SAPS Management already issued directives within the SAPS in an endeavor to avoid a repeat of such information breach.

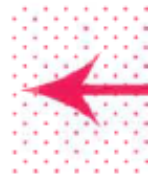
In order to mitigate the possible adverse effects of the disclosure of the mentioned personal information, it is recommended that you avoid commenting on social media regarding the matter.
