

**Did you know that the South African Police Service (SAPS) has an education trust to assist a child or children of employees of the SAPS who died in the line of duty and on duty?**

The SAPS's Educational Trust (SAPSET) provides financial and resource support to a child or children of an employee who has been appointed in terms of the South African Police Service Act, 1995 (Act no 68 of 1995) and the Public Service Act, 1994 (Act no 103 of 1994) and died in the performance of his or her duties by financing the costs of these children's educational needs.



Financial assistance entails a discretionary payment by the Trust on behalf of a child or children to an institution that is recognised, approved and accredited by the Department of Basic Education (Grade R to Grade 12) or the Department of Higher Education and Training (tertiary education). Resource support entails the provisioning of stationery and uniform according to the beneficiary's needs.

**The main beneficiaries of the SAPSET are children**

- of employees of the SAPS who died in the line of duty and on duty
- who are still receiving primary, secondary and tertiary education.

**The criteria for applications to become one of SAPSET's beneficiaries are as follows:**

- The date of the death of the employee of the SAPS must be after the inception date of the Trust, which is 23 November 2010.
- The death of the employee must have been while he or she was in the line of duty.
- The applicant must be a *bona fide* child of the deceased employee.
