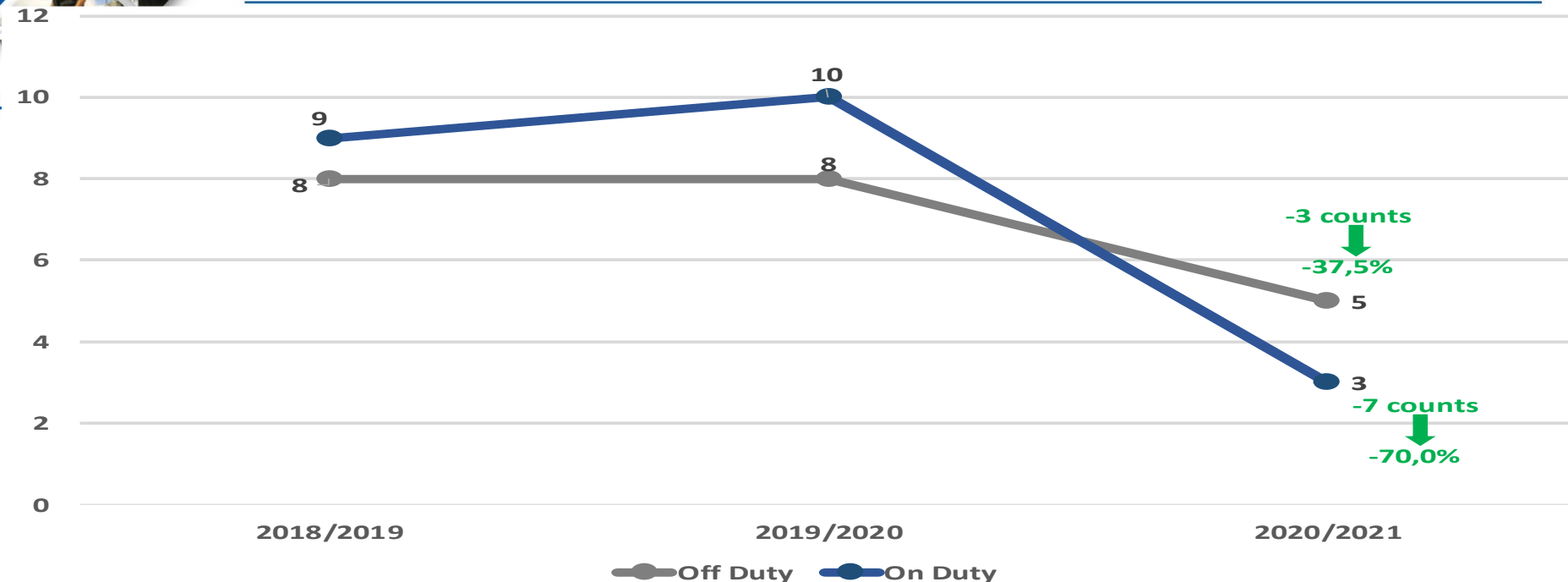

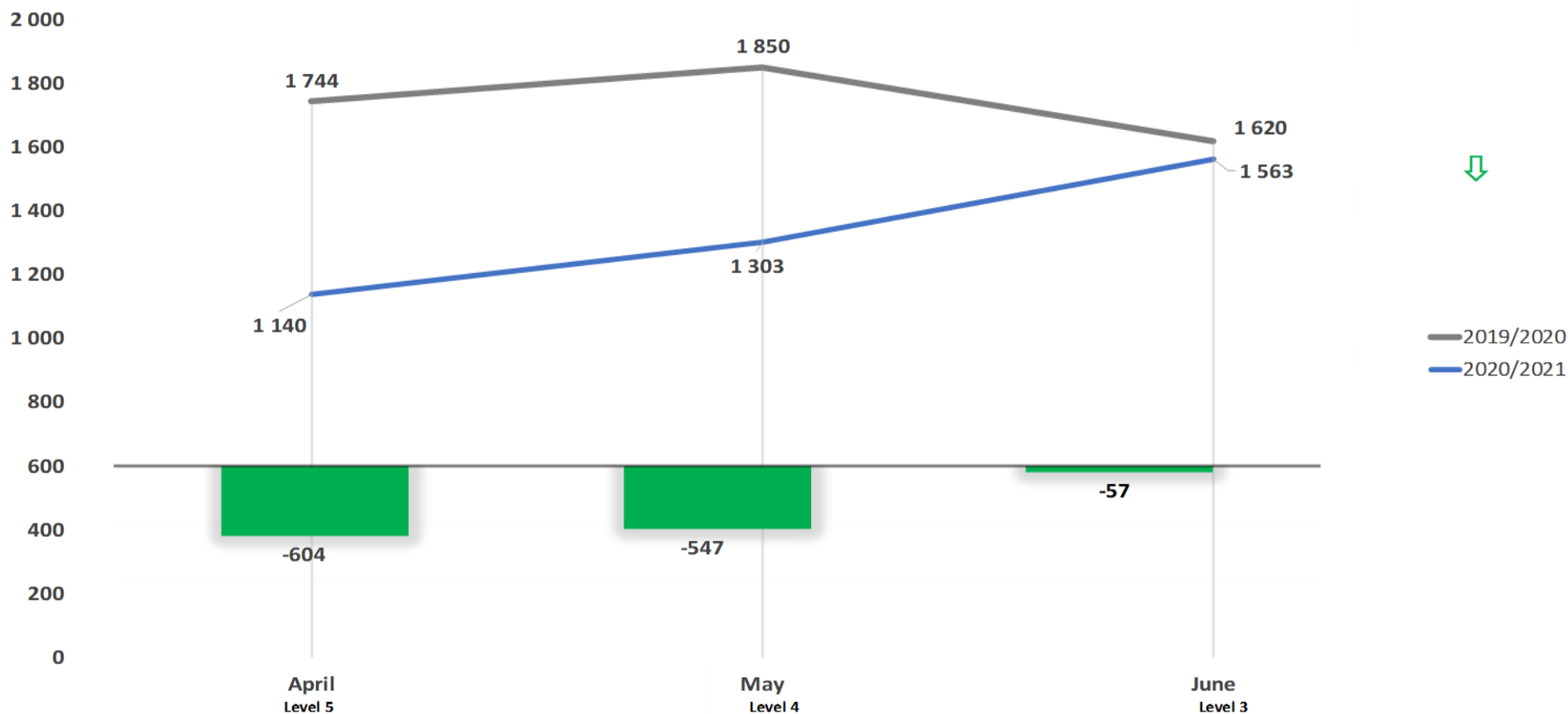


VICINITY OF THE CARJACKING: APRIL TO JUNE 2020_2021





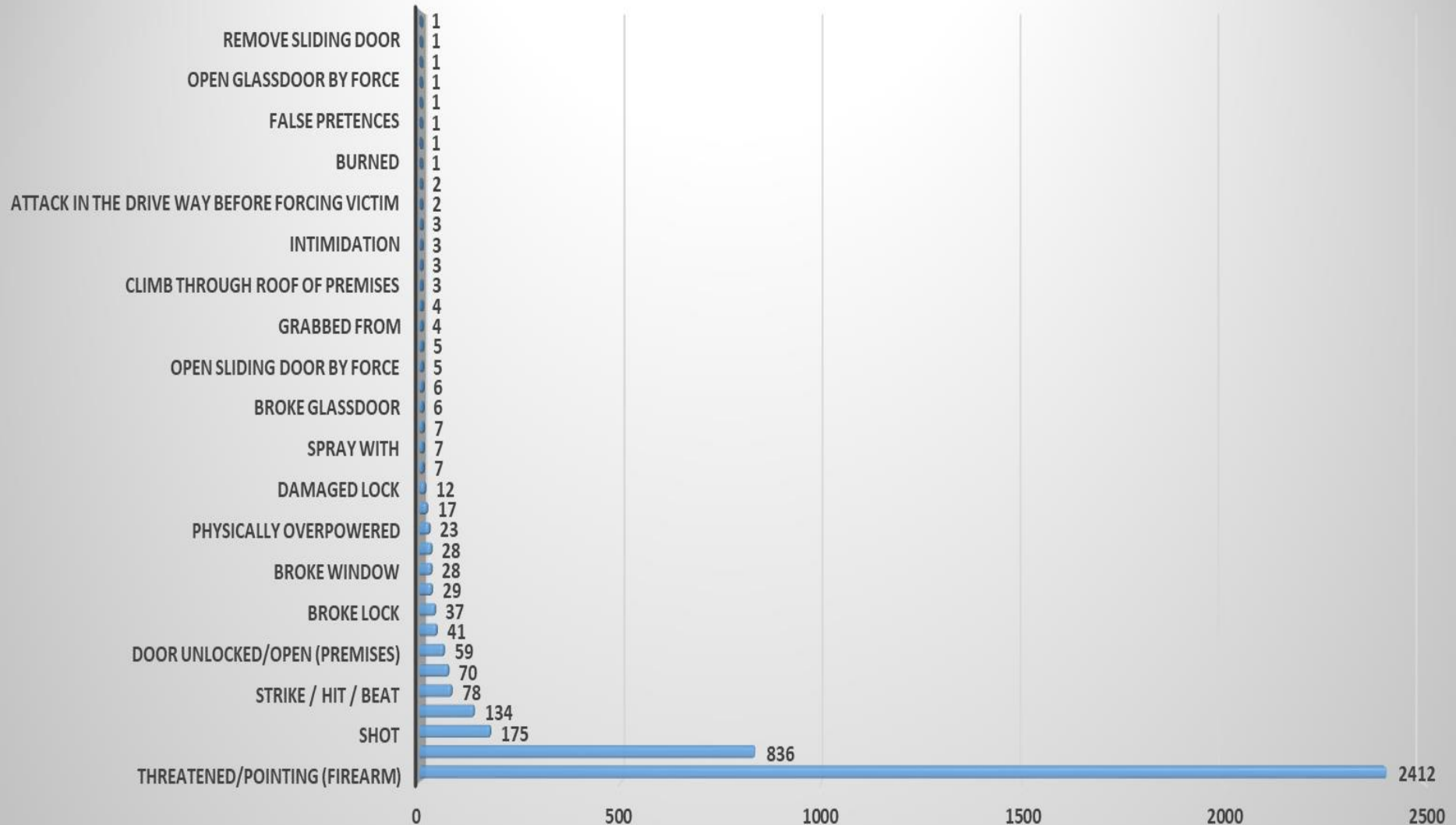

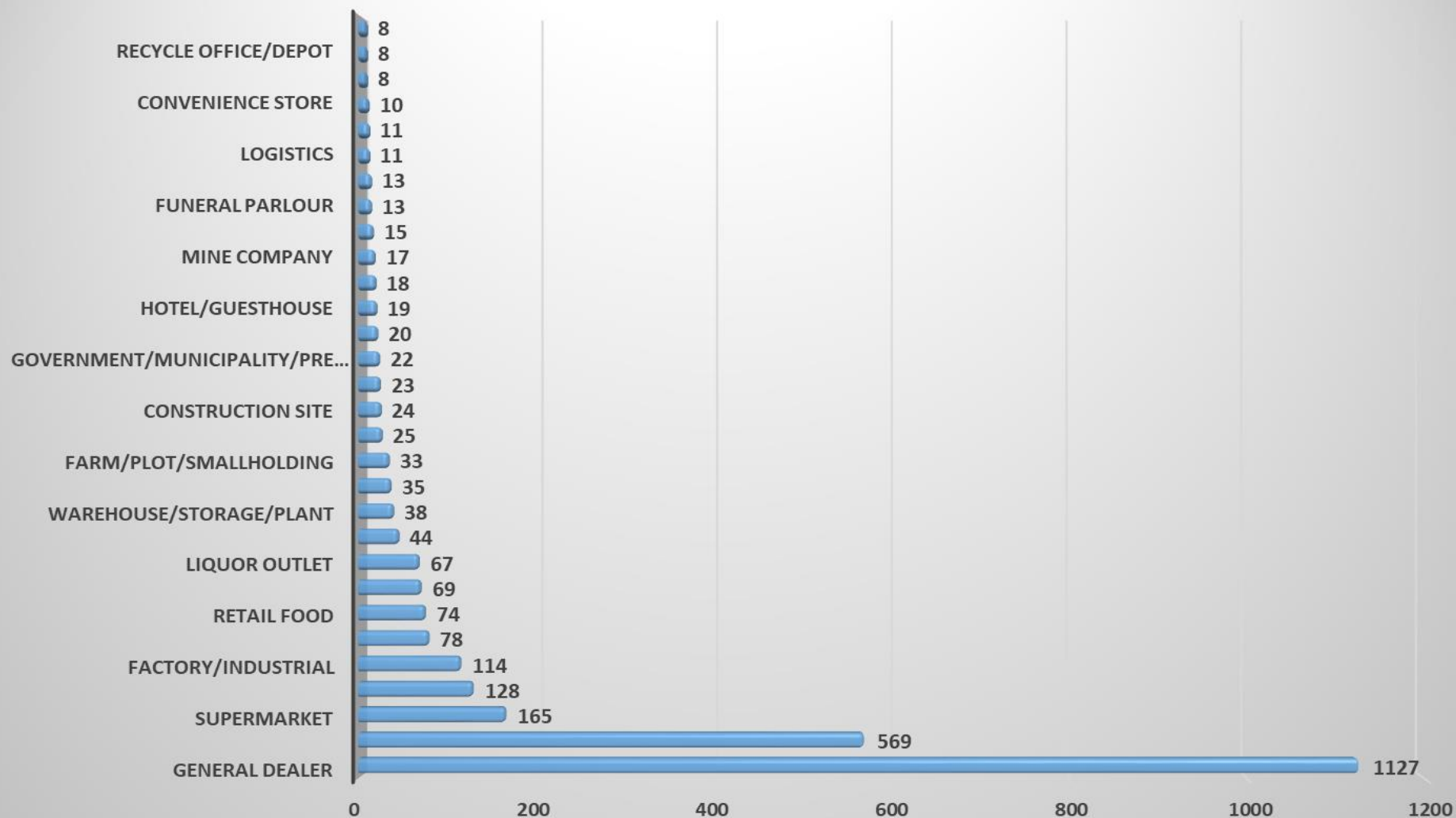

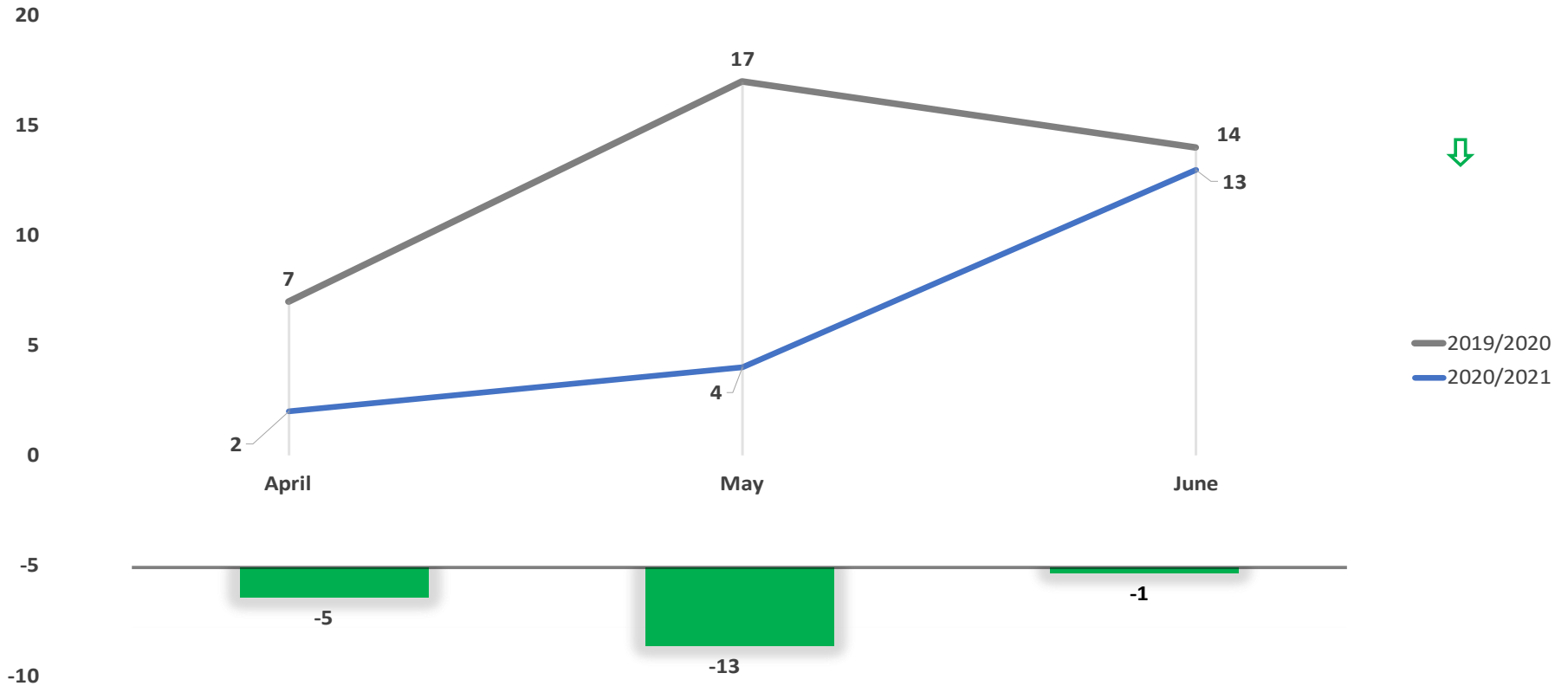


BUSINESS AT NON-RESIDENTIAL BUSINESS : TYPE OF BUSINESS

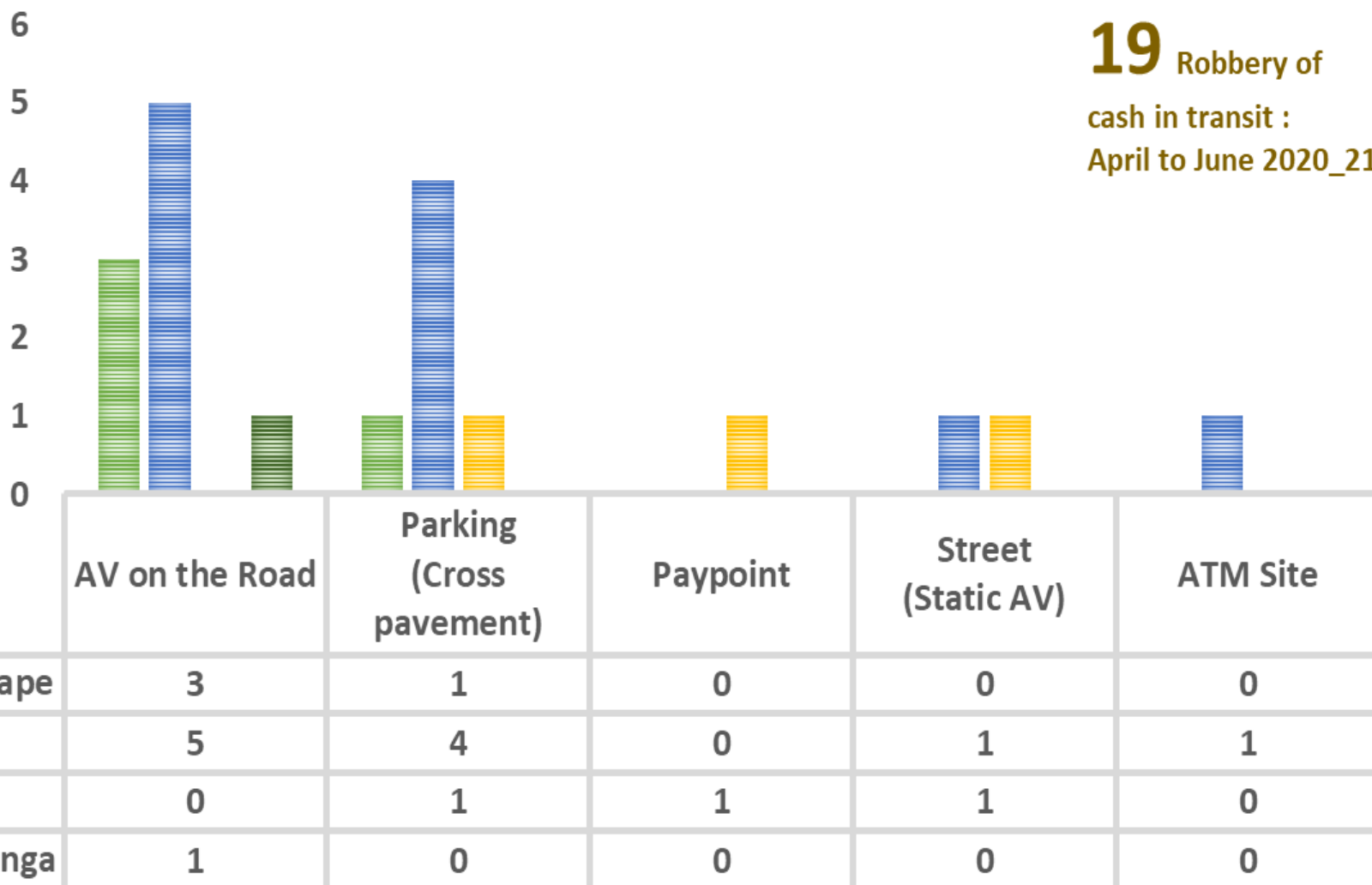


RSA: CIT ROBBERY

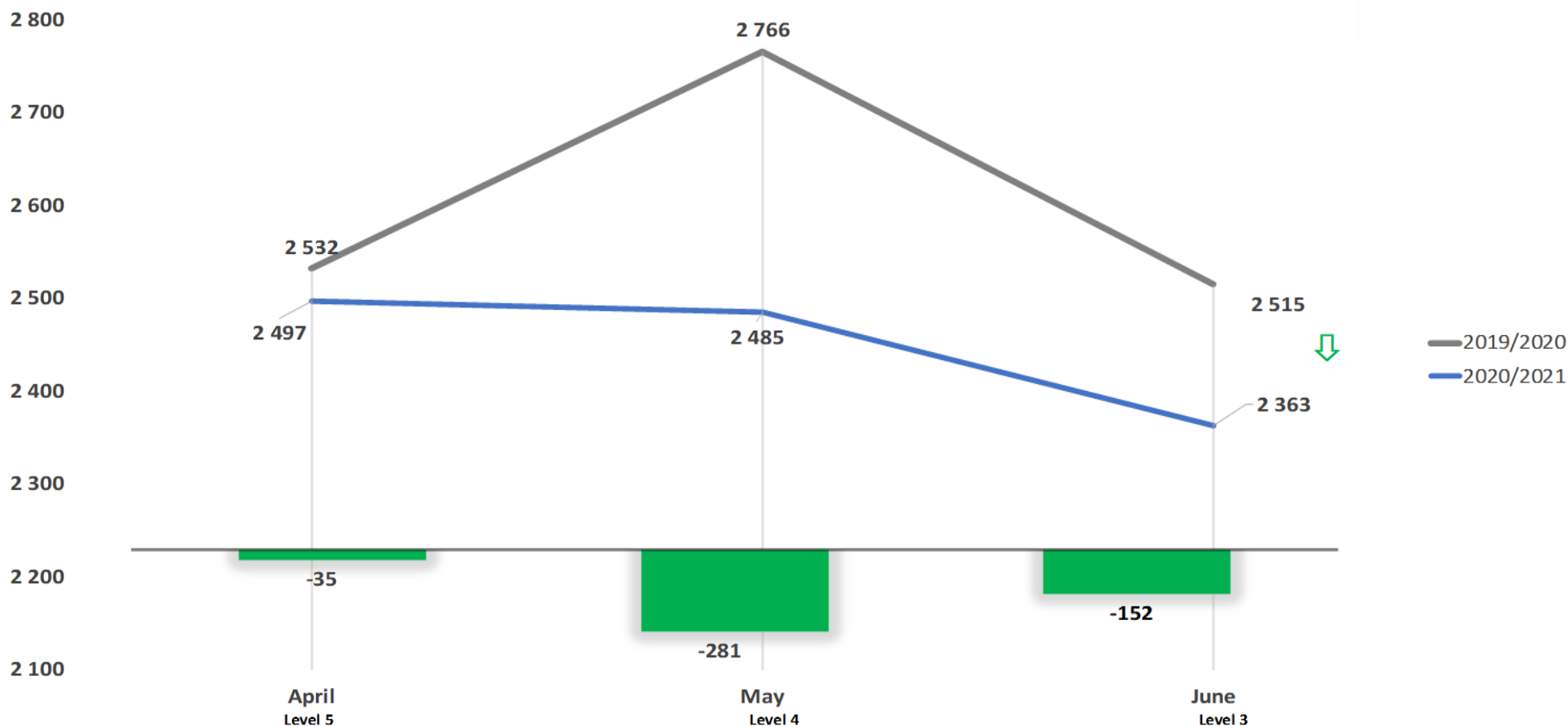
