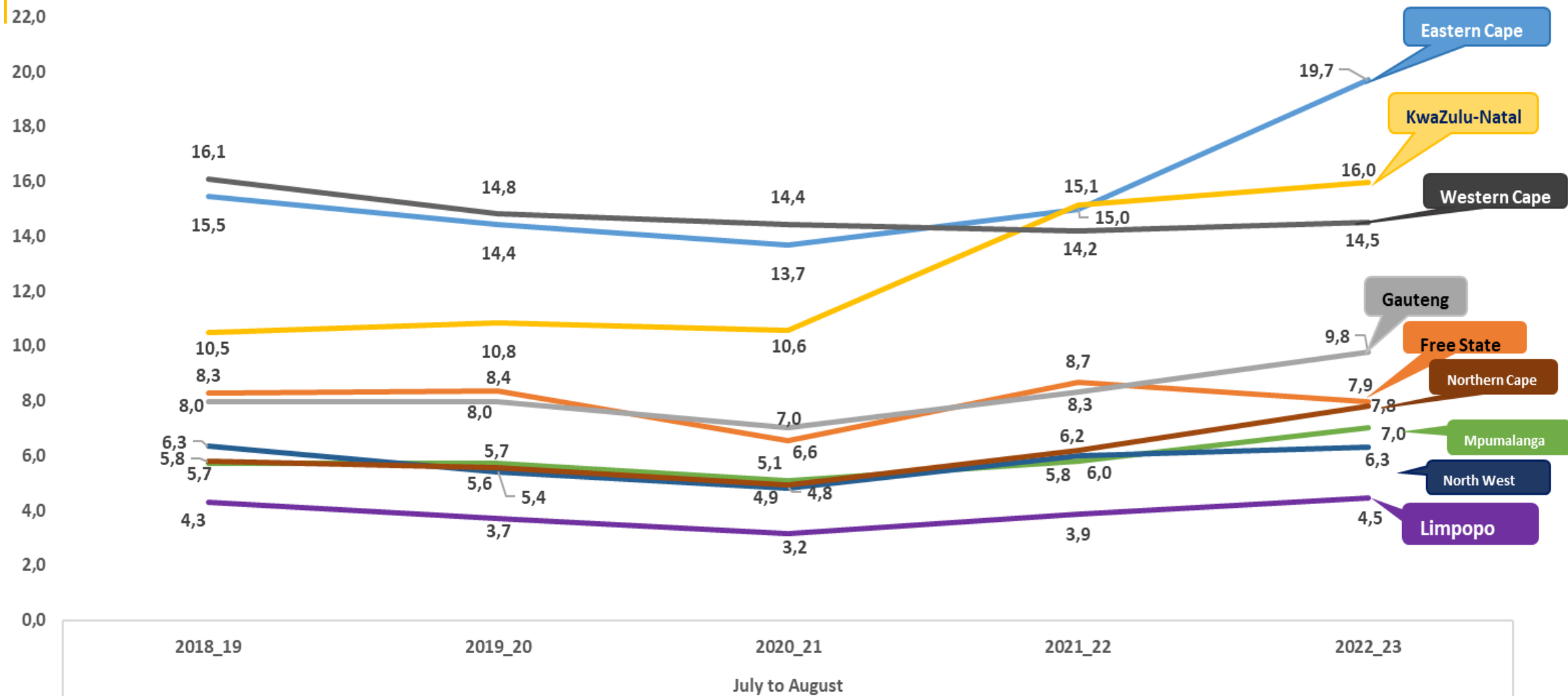

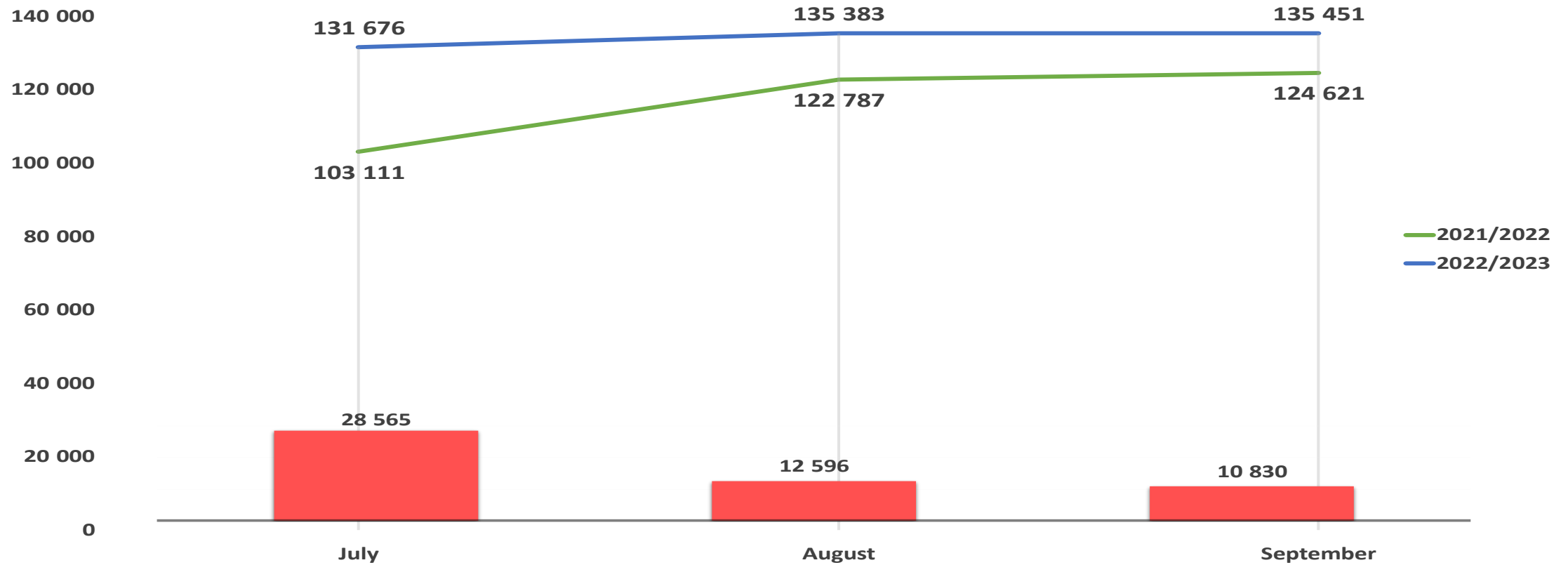

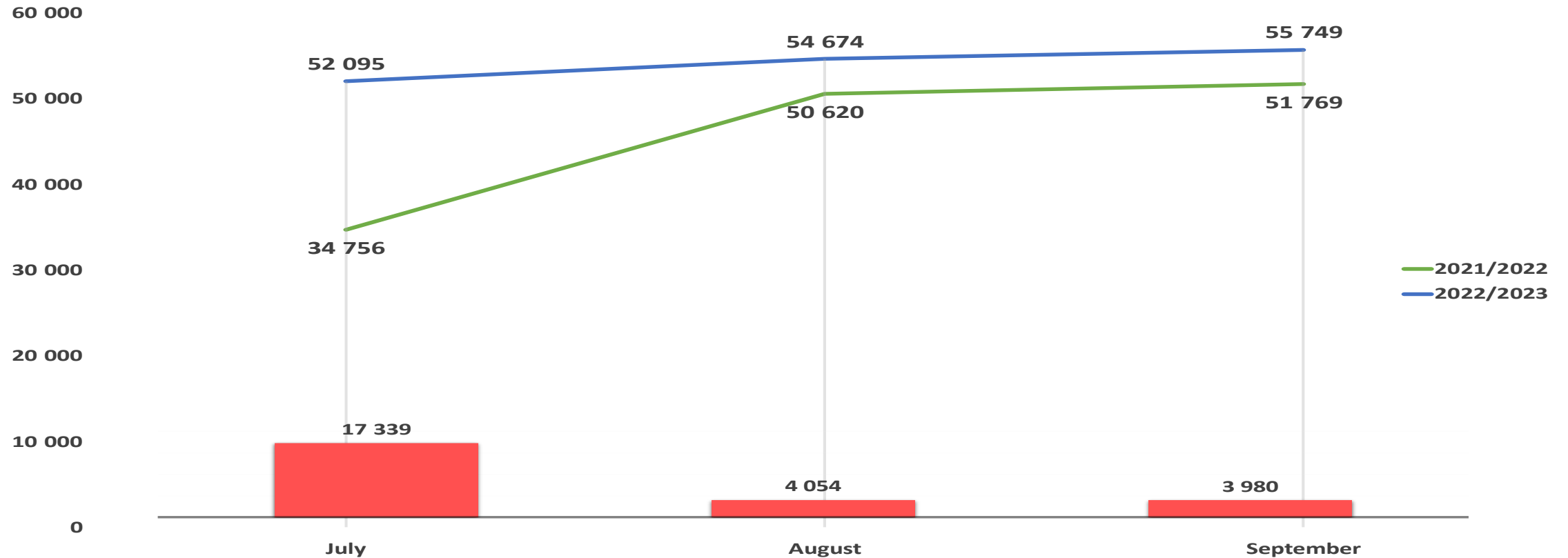

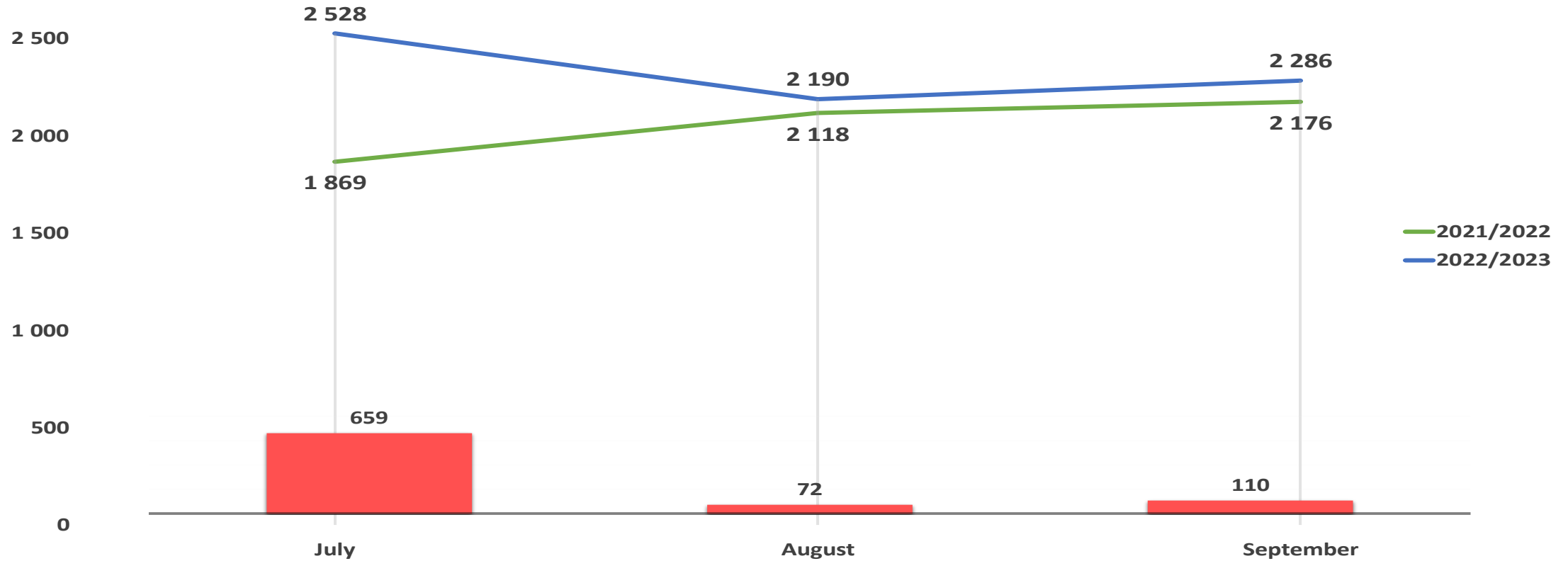

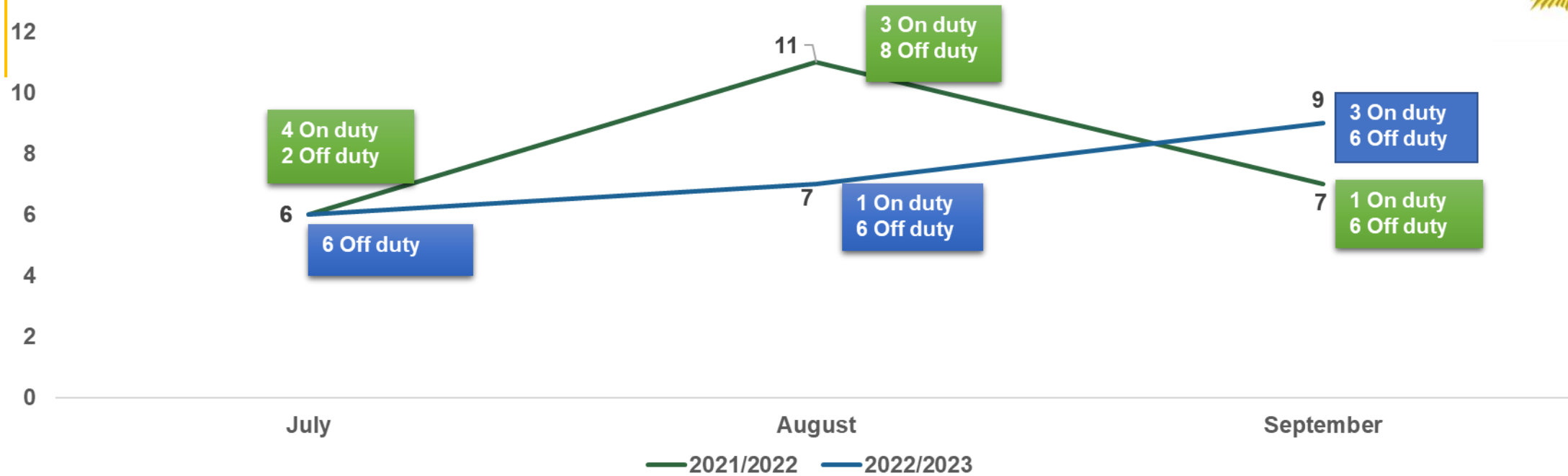

MURDER OF MEMBERS OF THE POLICE ON/OFF DUTY MEMBERS TREND OVER THREE-MONTH PERIOD



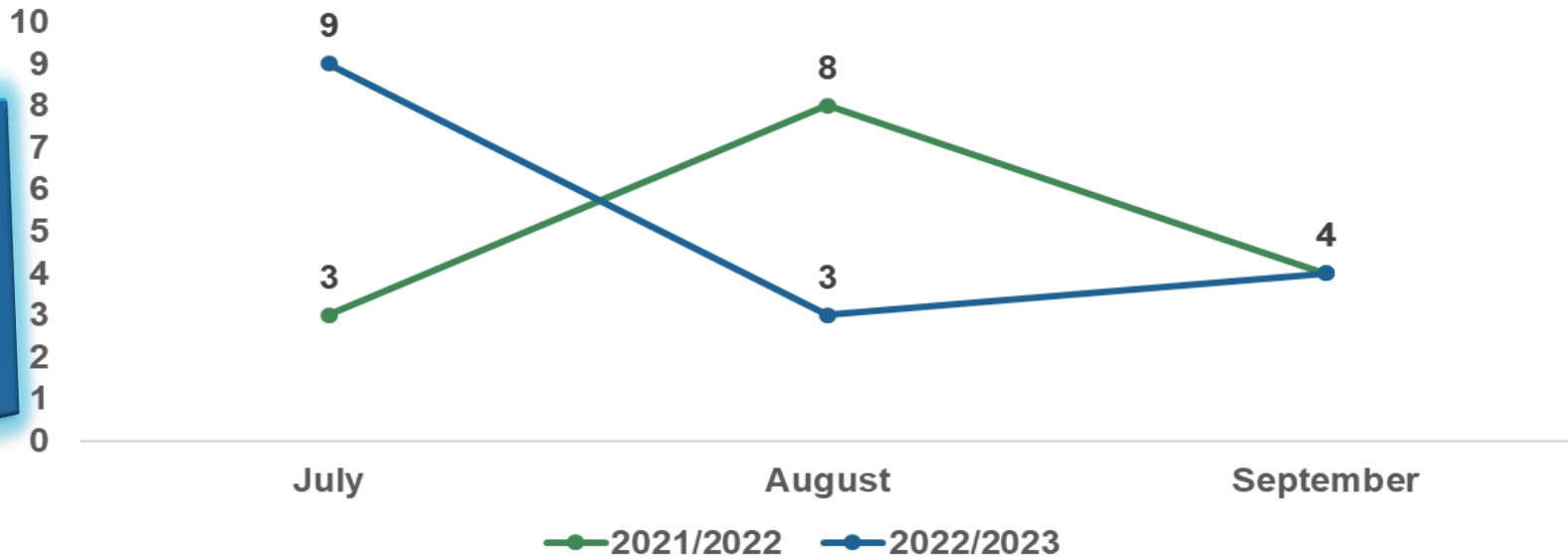

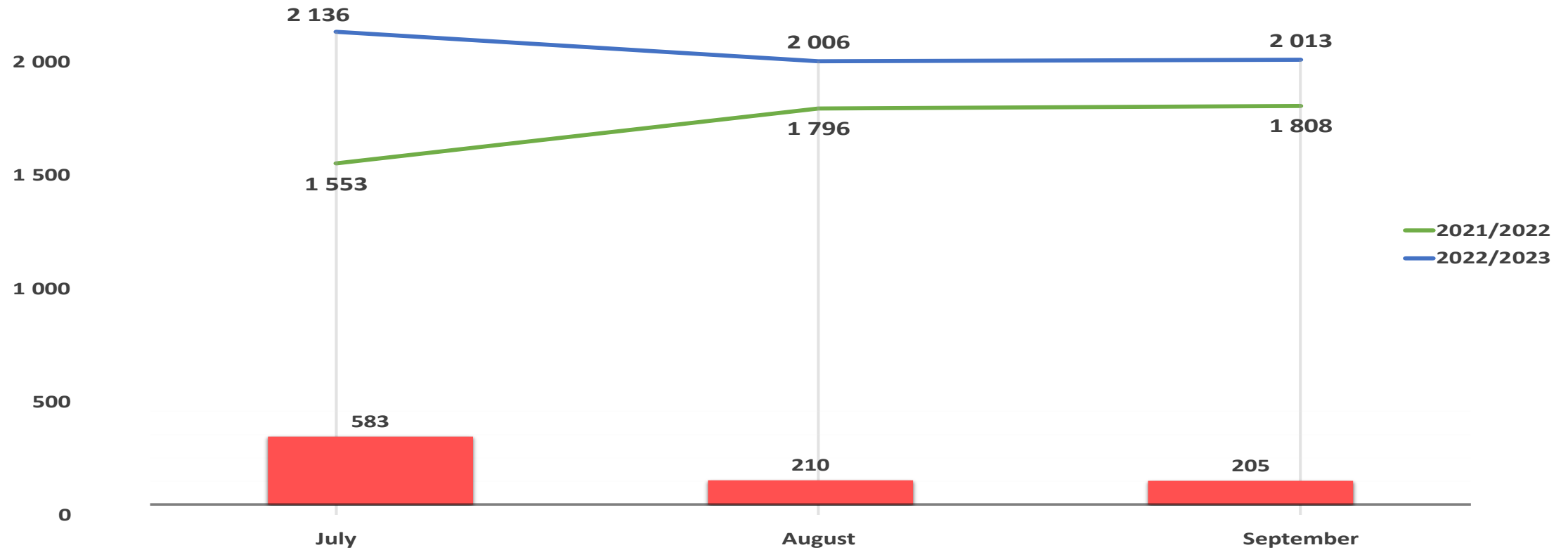

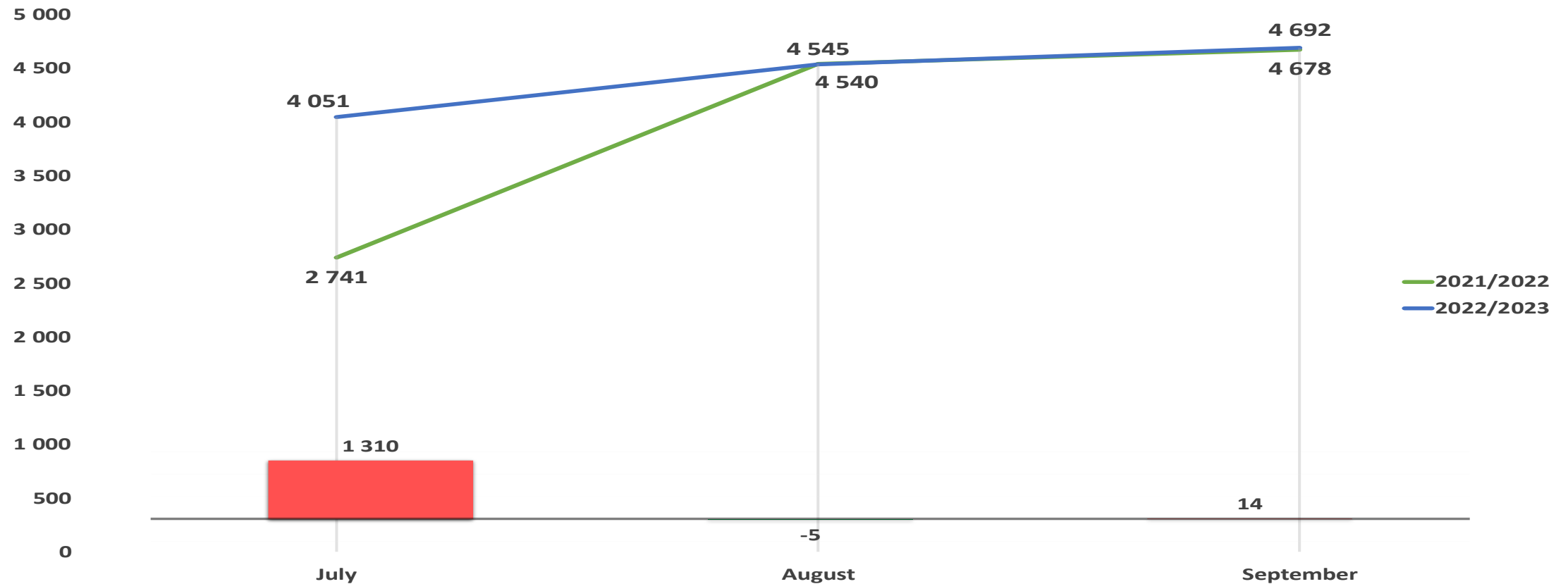

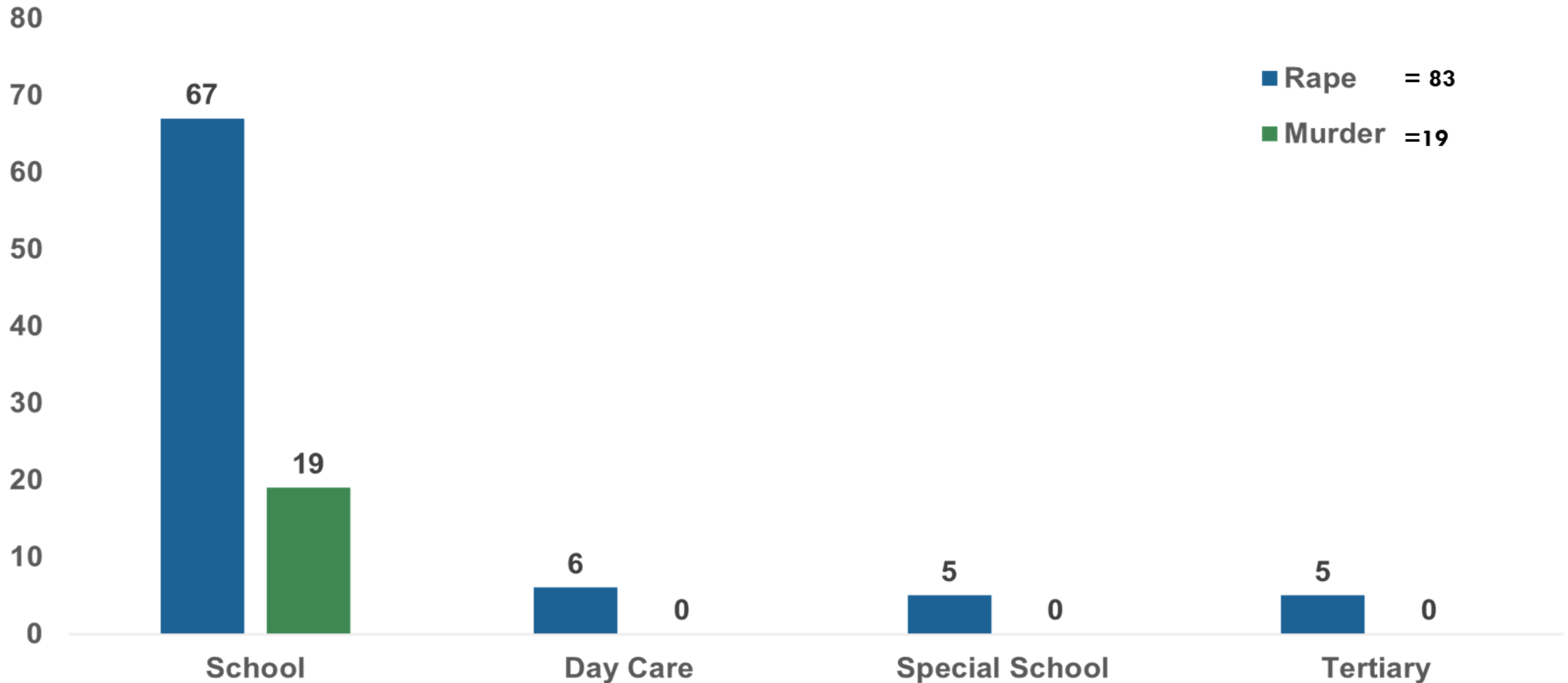

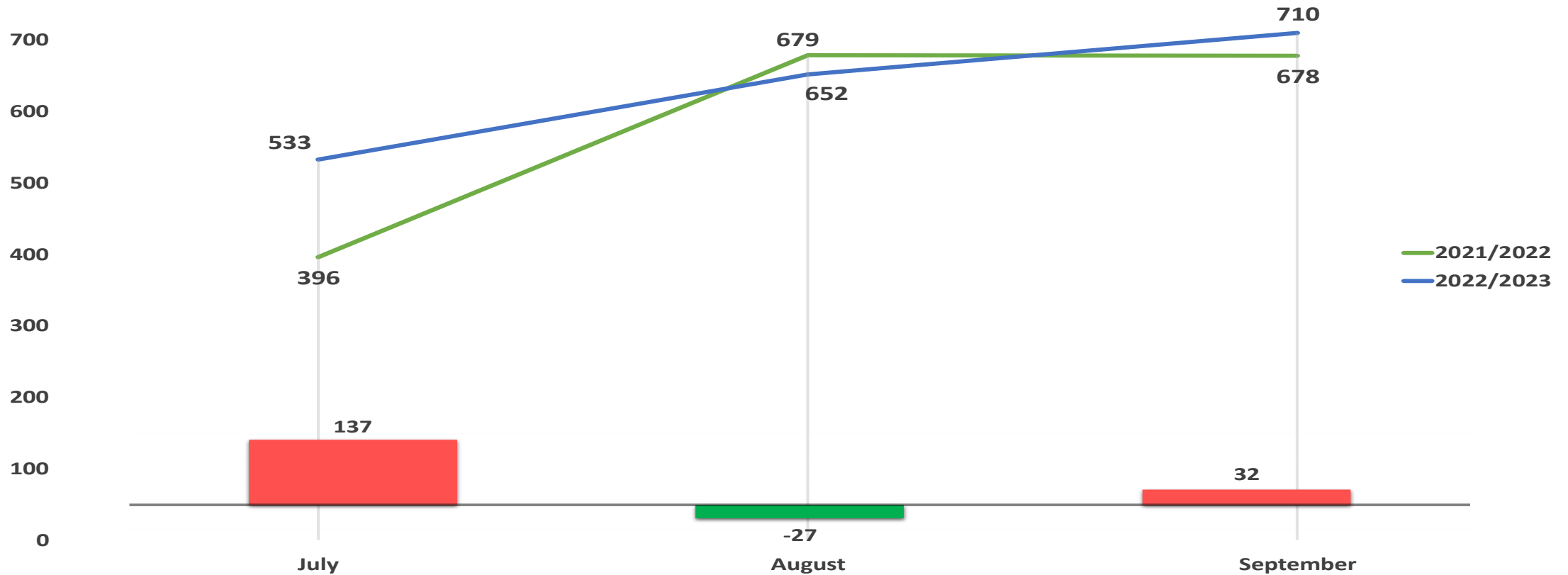

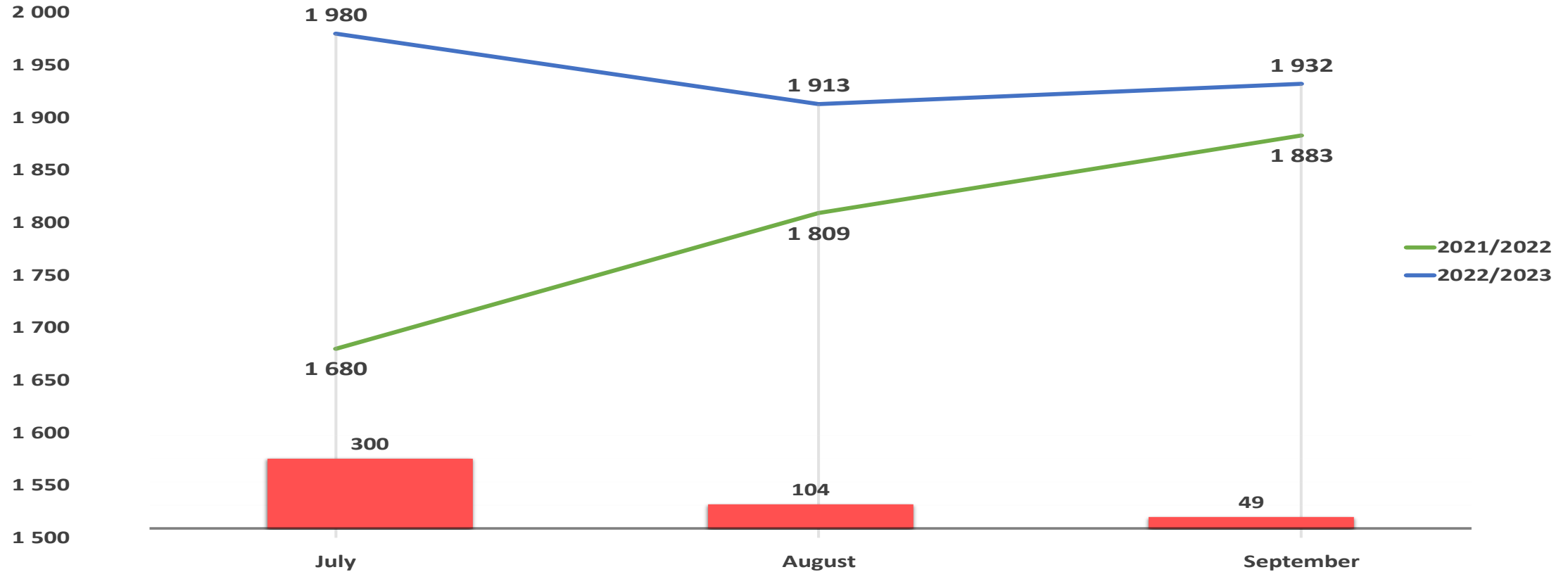

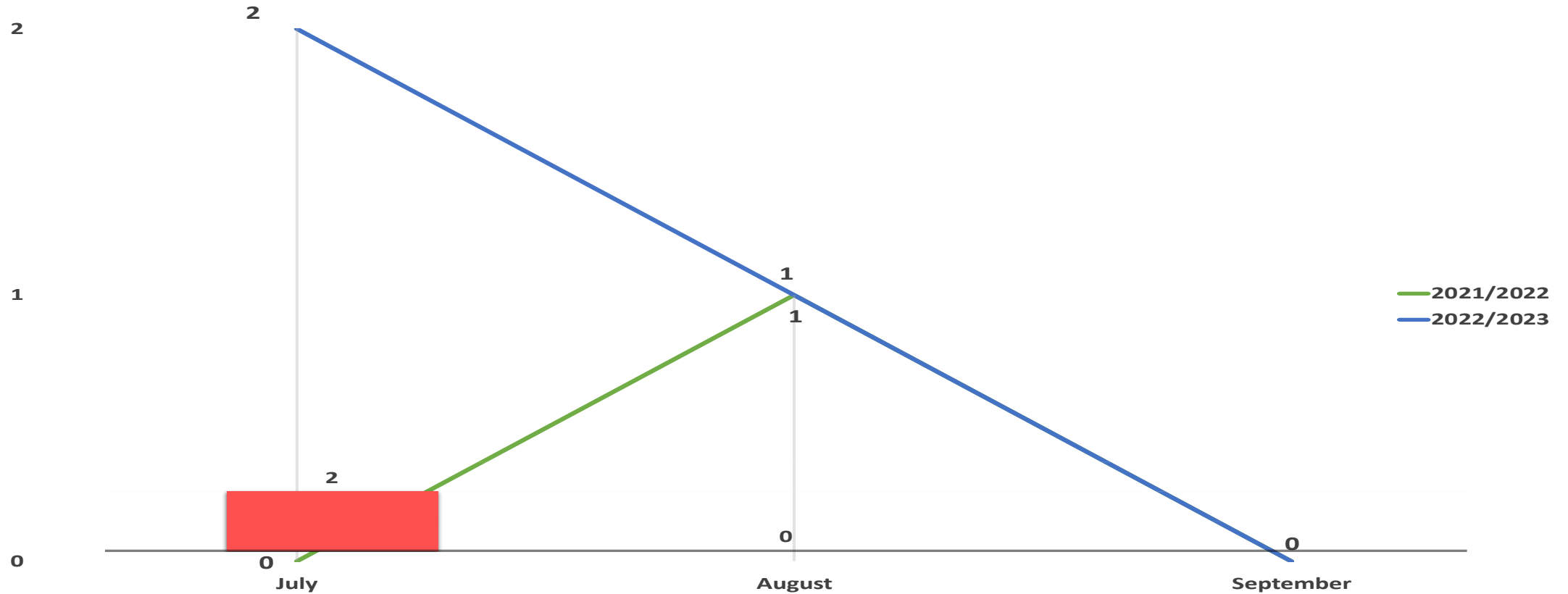


TYPE OF CIT JULY TO SEPTEMBER 2022/2023

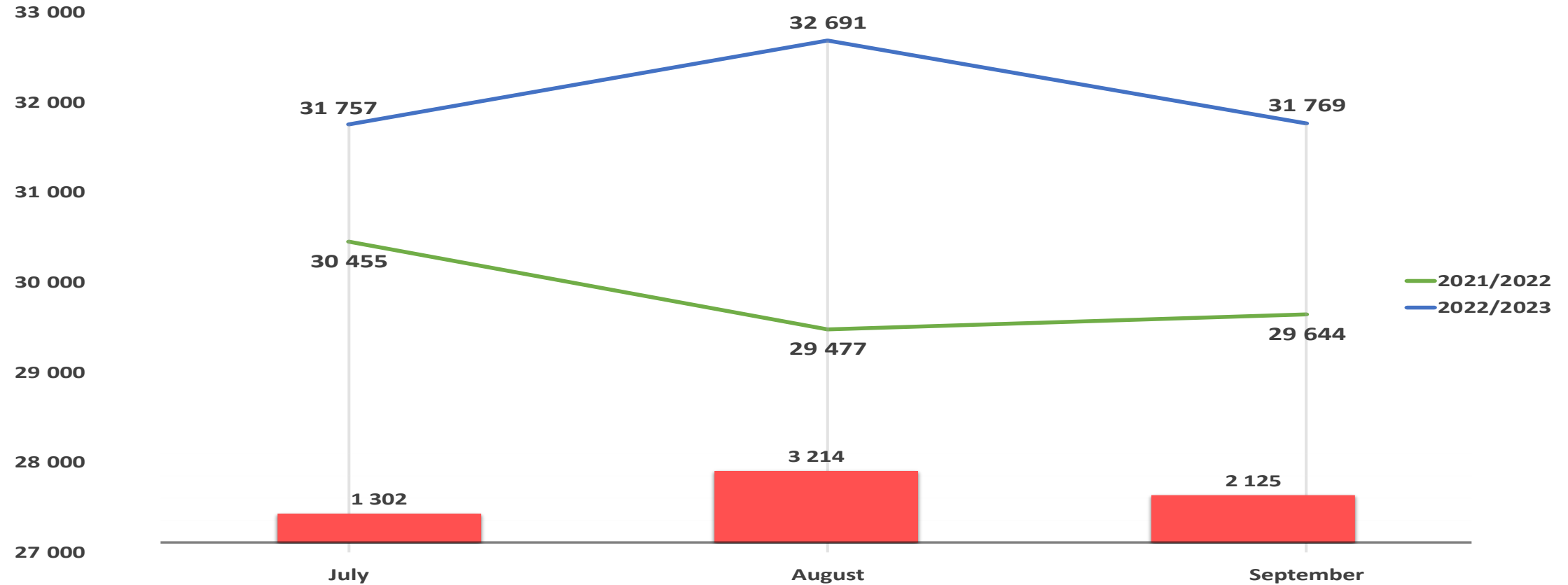

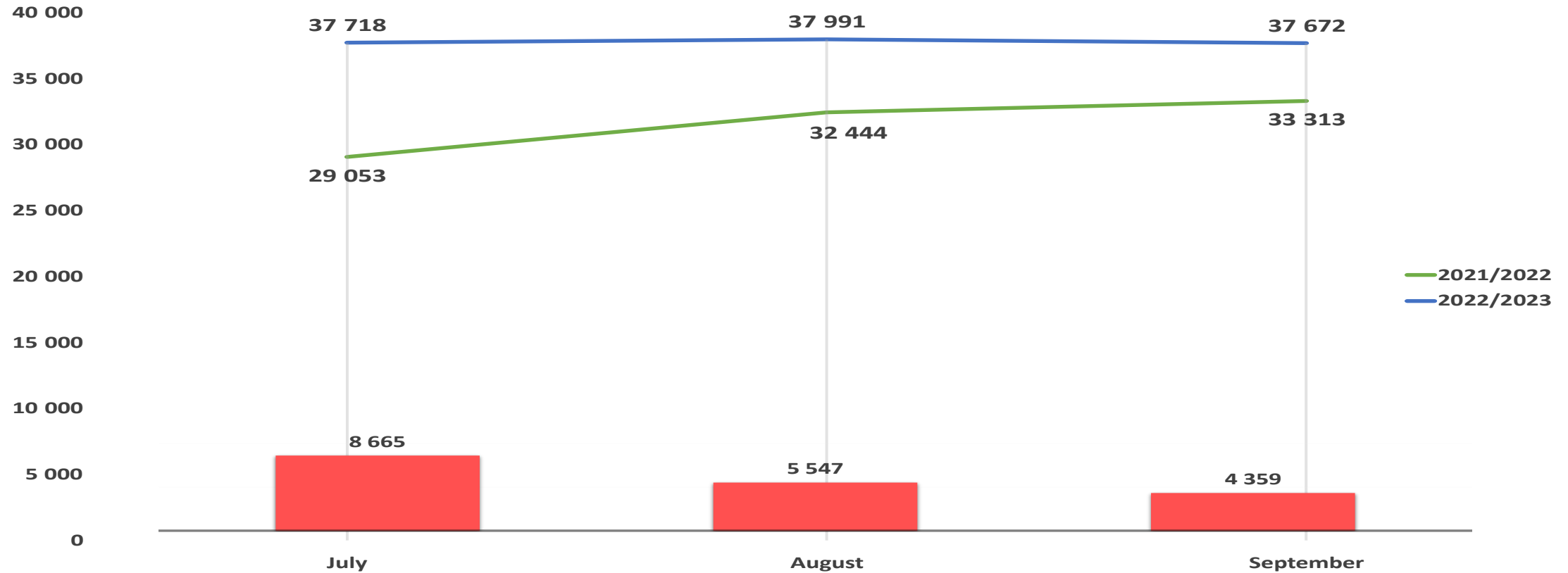


TYPE OF STOCK STOLEN

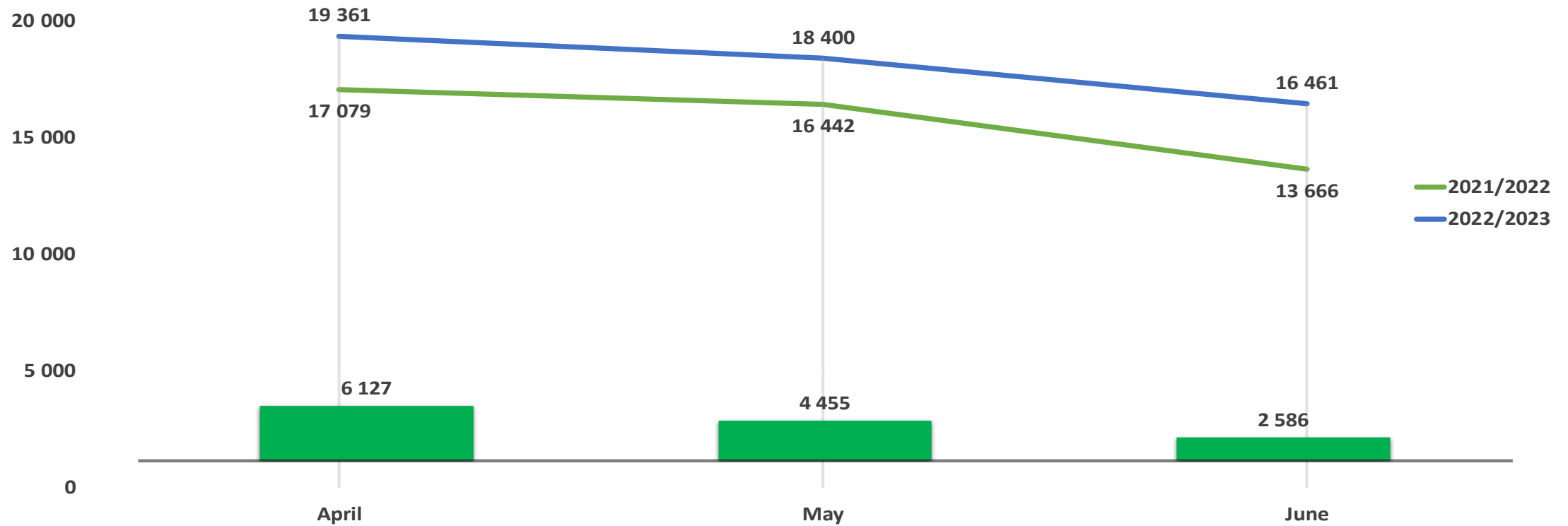

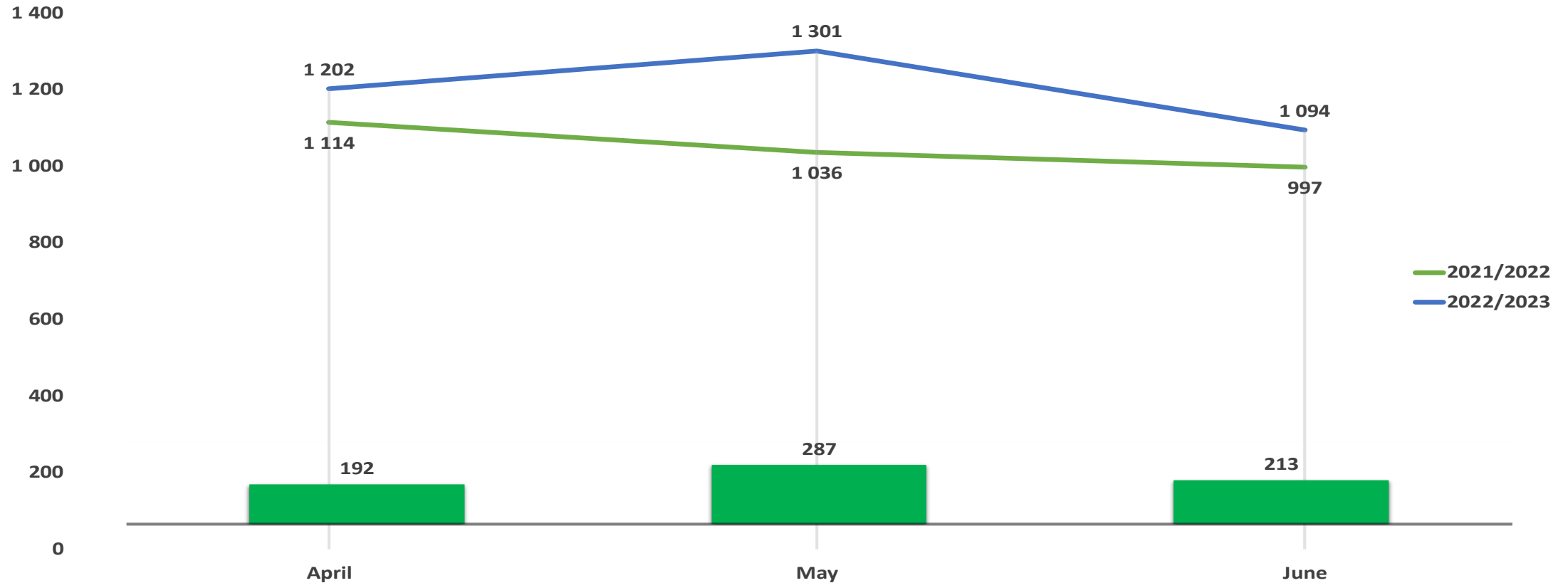
