

Licence your firearm in terms of the Firearm Control Act, 2000 (Act No 60 of 2000)



You need to apply for a firearm licence in terms of the Firearm Control Act, 2000 (Act No 60 of 2000) Visit your nearest police station and liaise with the Designated Firearm Officer who will assist you.

You will need the following :

- **Green barcoded Identity document or card or passport**
- **Original Competency Certificate**
- **2 colour passport photographs that is not older than 3 months**

Deceased Estate Firearms

A person who inherits a firearm and wishes to keep it may do one of the following:

- **Apply for an appropriate licence**
- **Deactivate the firearm or dispose of the firearm in accordance with the Provisions of the Firearms Control Act, 2000(Act No 60 of 2000)**
