Gunsmith's return: stock supplied

INSTRUCTIONS: GUNSMITH'S RETURN: STOCK SUPPLIED
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GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- The gunsmith's return form must be completed in black ink that cannot be erased.
- The return form must be stamped with the official date stamp when it is received at the Central Firearms Register (CFR).
- The gunsmith must complete Sections A, B, and C.
- The police official must complete Sections D and E.
- A person is guilty of an offence in terms of the Firearms Control Act, 2000 (Act No 60 of 2000), if he/she provides information which he/she knows is false on this gunsmith's return form.

1. Period from and to

The date from which and the date to which the stock was supplied must be recorded in paragraph 1.

SECTION A: GUNSMITH'S PARTICULARS**1. Trading as name of gunsmith**

The trading as name of the gunsmith must be recorded in paragraph A 1.

2. Licence number of gunsmith

The licence number of the gunsmith must be recorded in paragraph A 2.

SECTION B: DETAILS OF FIREARM(S) SUPPLIED**1. Firearm(s) type**

The type of firearm(s) supplied must be recorded in paragraph B 1.

2. Model

The model of the firearm(s) supplied must be recorded in paragraph B 2.

3. Calibre

The calibre of the firearm(s) supplied must be recorded in paragraph B 3.

4. Serial number

The serial number(s) of the firearm(s) supplied must be recorded in paragraph B 4.

5. Make

The make of the firearm(s) supplied must be recorded in paragraph B 5.

SECTION C: TO WHOM SUPPLIED**1. Name**

The name of the party to whom the firearm was supplied must be recorded in paragraph C 1.

2. Identification/Passport/FAR No

The identification number of the party to whom the firearm was supplied must be recorded in paragraph C 2.

3. Licence No

The applicable licence number of the party to whom the firearm was supplied must be recorded in paragraph C 3.

4. Date received

The date on which the firearm was supplied must be recorded in paragraph C 4.

5. The gunsmith must declare that he/she is aware that it is an offence to provide false information in this return form.

6. Signature of responsible person

The responsible person must sign in paragraph C 6.

7. Name of the responsible person in block letters

The initials and surname (in block letters) of the responsible person must be recorded in paragraph C 7.

8. Date

The date on which the responsible person signs the gunsmith's return form must be recorded in paragraph C 8.

SECTION D: ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RECEIPT (FOR OFFICIAL USE BY THE SOUTH AFRICAN POLICE SERVICE)**1. PARTICULARS OF FIREARM(S) THAT COULD NOT BE REGISTERED****2. Firearm type**

The type of the firearm(s) that could not be registered must be recorded in paragraph D 2.

3. Model

The model of the firearm(s) that could not be registered must be recorded in paragraph D 3.

4. Calibre

The calibre of the firearm(s) that could not be registered must be recorded in paragraph D 4.

5. Serial number

The serial number(s) of the firearm(s) that could not be registered must be recorded in paragraph D 5.

6. Make

The make of the firearm(s) that could not be registered must be recorded in paragraph D 6.

7. Remarks

The remarks of the official who processes the gunsmith's return must be recorded in paragraph D 7.

SECTION E: PARTICULARS OF OFFICIAL RESPONSIBLE FOR THE REGISTRATION OF THE FIREARM DETAILS**1. Name of official in block letters**

The initials and surname (in block letters) of the official who processes the gunsmith's return must be recorded in paragraph E 1.

2. Rank of official in block letters

The rank (in block letters) of the official who processes the gunsmith's return must be recorded in paragraph E 2.

3. Persal number of official

The SAPS Persal number of the official who processes the gunsmith's return must be recorded in paragraph E 3.

4. Signature of official

The signature of the official who processes the gunsmith's return must be recorded in paragraph E 4.
